20. Mary, in Her Humility, Proclaims the Greatness of the Lord, Diary of a MOC (p 66-67)

“My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord.” My little one, these are the words from the mouth of My Mother as she enters the home of Elizabeth. Ponder these words with Me. My Mother lived her life in praise of the Father. She lived in the constant awareness of who the Father is. Her soul was in a constant state of awe.

At the moment of the Incarnation, My human and divine Heart was fused as ONE with My Mother's and was consumed in the fire of love of the Holy Spirit. Together we proclaim the greatness of the Father.

In the knowledge of the greatness and majesty of God, Mary also had perfect knowledge of herself; therefore, she states that she is the handmaid of the Lord.

My daughter, I desire that you live more profoundly and perfectly in the knowledge of the grandeur, majesty and goodness of Abba, our Father. In this way, you will live more perfectly as My handmaid. The perfect and holy handmaid of the Lord, Mary Most Holy, is moved by the Holy Spirit to serve her cousin, Elizabeth.

Do you understand, My little one, the direct correlation with the Mothers of the Cross? The Spirit of God moves the pure and humble of heart to serve as handmaids their brothers and sisters, sons and daughters, in the awareness of who God is, in order to become the handmaids of God. The true knowledge of God will always move a soul to serve in pure humility. You are the handmaids of the Lord; serve one another in the awareness of the immensity of God's love. (09/18/11)

I. WHO IS THE FATHER

- Mary lived her life on earth in:
 1. praise of the Father
 2. the constant awareness of who the Father is.
 3. a constant state of awe.

- Mary lives as ONE HEART with Jesus loving and honoring the Father; proclaiming His---GOODNESS, MAJESTY, MERCY, FAITHFULNESS, LOVE, TENDERNESS, COMPASSION, FORGIVENESS....

- **Exodus 34:6-7**
The Lord passed before him (Moses), and proclaimed,
“The Lord, the Lord,
a God merciful and gracious,

slow to anger,
and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness,
keeping steadfast love for the thousandth generation,[b]
forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin..."

- **Isaiah 49:15-16**

Can a woman forget her nursing child,
or show no compassion for the child of her womb?
Even these may forget,
yet I will not forget you.
See, I have inscribed you on the palms of my hands

- Who is the Father? Have I come to know Him personally? Do I live in a constant state of awe and praise because I truly know Him?

*I am making all things new. Do you think that My death and resurrection was useless and powerless? No, My little one, I am making all things new, yet few believe, they have not come to know Me, My Father and the power of the Holy Spirit...). If My words remain in your hearts, you will **persevere through the many trials predestined for you to suffer for the glory of God** and the salvation of countless souls. I desire to see each of you rejoicing ALWAYS, in good times and in bad, because you have come to believe that I am with you. You have come to taste the goodness of the Lord. Joy is the fruit of trust, and therefore, My followers live in the praise of God. My witnesses will be known in the world through the light of praise and joy that radiates from your lives...*

II. **The Spirit of God moves the pure and humble of heart to serve , in the awareness of who God is, in the awareness of the immensity of God's love.**

- **Isaiah 49:1,3** –The LORD called me from the womb, from the body of my mother he named me. 3 And he said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified."

- As MOC we are called to serve one another as VICTIMS OF LOVE.

- *The Mothers of the Cross unite their fiat to My Mother of the Cross as victim intercessors.*

- EX. – Moses – He takes off the veil to enter in the presence of God. He comes transparent, unveiled, before God the Father (Exodus 34:34). Moses speaks to the Father as a child with trust, for he knows the goodness of the Lord and he intercedes for the “stiff-necked” people. His intercession is blessed by the mercy and kindness of our Father.

How the Father loves:

1. Grief
2. Desire
3. Hope
4. Endless Waiting

1. GRIEF

- As Father, the only authority he claims for himself is the authority of compassion. That authority comes from letting **the sins of all his children pierce his heart**. There is no lust, greed, anger, resentment, jealousy, or vengeance in his lost children that has not caused immense grief to his heart. **The grief is so deep because the heart is so pure.**
- **Our SERVICE as Spiritual Mothers:**
We, the MOC, must allow our hearts to be crowned with Jesus' crown of thorns. We must be willing to receive the crown of the disorders, sins, brokenness, wounds, hypocrisy, hardness, pride... of a man God places in our lives—husband, father, son, uncle, priest, boss... and suffer as one the grief of Abba through Christ with Mary. WE must allow our pierced feminine hearts to be cleansed of all resentment, anger, irritation, revenge, pride, vanity..., our contaminated blood, in order to love through, with and in the Blood of Christ.
- “As I’ve prayed these last weeks, it seems as though the woman HAS to, and will always be, the vessel of healing for the men. But, in order for me to do that, any pride, hardness of heart, judgment, and expectation had to be replaced with the Eucharistic love Christ has planted deep in my heart so that I could truly be through Him, with Him, and in Him. It makes my heart wonder and pray about whether most men have that capability without the “woman” going first to be that vessel of offering and sacrifice.” Ammie Degrange

2. DESIRE

- What is the desire of the Father?
To bring His children home to live in the joy of the banquet of God’s love. That every person may come to know Him, love Him and honor Him.
 - **Isaiah 49: 5**
And now the Lord says,
who formed me in the womb to be his servant,

to bring Jacob back to him,
and that Israel might be gathered to him,
 for I am honored in the sight of the Lord,
 and my God has become my strength—

- This desire of Abba must become our only desire also. Therefore, our own desires focused on self must be crucified.
 Example:
 “Creo que puedo tratarla con libertad, sin buscar en ella mi "validation", pero sí apreciando su corazón femenino de hermana, y compartiendo con ella las bendiciones que el Señor me ha dado.” Priest
- **2 Cor. 4:11-12**
 “For while we live, we are always being given up to death for Jesus’ sake, so that the life of Jesus may be made visible in our mortal flesh. So death is at work in us, but life in you.”

3. HOPE

- *It is the hidden force of the Mothers of the Cross that will help to bring to life the dead bones of My sons (priests). 8/10/11 Simple Path p.38*

4. ENDLESS WAITING

- The Father does not force, constrain, push or pull – CONTROL.
- We must too be willing to WAIT without INSISTING on our own way, forcing and controlling.

III. SILENCE

➤ Gaze of love — her tenderness

*I need you. I need each of you to bring My tenderness in mercy to the world. It is love manifested through the tenderness of God that has the power to touch the hardened hearts of many souls. My little ones, learn from Mary, the Mother of God and your Mother. **Her tenderness is manifested in Her silence as the love and mercy of God radiates from her gaze. Her gaze is the gaze of God and her gaze has the power to penetrate the darkness of Satan. God the Father desires that each of you become the gaze of Mary upon the earth.***

How my Lord do we become Mary’s gaze?

*By learning to **live My tenderness through silence.** My little ones, the eyes are the window of the heart and it is I who dwells in your hearts. You must believe that through your fiats to be My victim souls I have taken My abode in your hearts. Allow My merciful love to radiate through your gaze through the power of silence. The power of God radiated through Mary through the power of her silence. Remember what I taught you about silence. 8/4/18*
